CVV Moves to New Database Software

CVV is in the process of transitioning its database software from Club Express to Helpful Village. The move is expected to simplify the use of the CVV database.

Helpful Village is the software developed by an Ashby Village volunteer, Manuel Acevedo, to simplify the key village tasks involved in delivering services including member requests, database management (provider, member & volunteer), and events coordination.

The CVV web site team of Nancy Hoffman, Bill Martin, Christine Jeffers, and Maria Xiaris is in the midst of a trial and training period to learn how to use the new database.

Prior to making the decision to change, members of the CVV Task Force met with Acevedo to get acquainted with Helpful Village. The most recent meeting was at the Walnut Creek library on June 20.

Dream On, Dancing Queen is set in Clayton




